



# Principal Request for Expulsion

(Expulsion Packet)

*Expulsion is the suspension of a student from regular classroom instruction for a period exceeding five (5) school days for violation of an act enumerated in Section 48900 or 48915 of the California Education Code. A student may be expelled for any 48900 or 48915 education code except for K, you cannot expel a student on a 48900 K violation alone. In order to expel a student, you must show that:*

1. *“Other means of correction are not feasible or have repeatedly failed to bring about proper conduct.” and/or*
2. *“Due to the nature of the violation the presence of the student causes a continued danger to the physical safety of the student, or others (48915).”*

The finding must spell out the facts (where, when, what) sufficiently to verify the student engaged in misconduct. The finding must be based upon evidence provided during the expulsion hearing, not information provided in any non-formal expulsion documents or conversation. If the student has an IEP, the manifestation results and date need to be included.*
